

Our bands have become an integral part of Philadelphia's history. We have represented you and our City in Canada, Cuba, Germany, England, France and just about every state in the United States of America.


We are also proud that 1987 was the first time ever that the Mummer's Parade was televised nationally. Local coverage was hand-led by KYW-TV3.




He started his string band career as a saxophone player with Quaker City, along with his father Bob, Sr., who is still very active with the band after 48 years, and his younger brother Jack.

The Peter A. Broomall String Band is proud to announce that our 1987 feature on the man behind the scenes is our very own Mr. Roger Gartner.



the Hegeman String Band. He played with Hegeman for two years, went to Ferko for a year and then returned to Hegeman at the request of Captain Al Fink, with whom he would develop a special lifelong friendship. In 1958, Carl's son, Don, joined the band as a saxophone player. He is still marching with Hegeman.

Carl was one of the most dedicated and beloved members in Hegeman's history. Even after he retired to a home in Villas, NJ in 1980, he kept in touch with the band and members visited him from time to time.

When he was not taking part in Mummies activities, Carl owned and operated a hardware store in North Philadelphia with his wife of 49 years, Florence. He died on November 7, 1986 at the age of 72.

The Jankiewicz family expresses their deep appreciation to all of the members of the Philadelphia String Band Association for bestowing this honor on Carl. He would have been extremely proud.

Carl Jankiewicz was a Mummer for more than 50 years. He strutted up Broad Street for the first time in the 1924 Mummies Parade — at the age of 10 — as a mascot in Philadelphia's original Kensington String Band. Although Carl's father Ignatious was not a Mummer, he **did** play the concertina. And following his lead, Carl grew into a fine musician, learning the violin, accordion and both the tenor and alto saxophones.

By 1933, he was ready to lead the band as music director. Carl later marched as the captain of the band on January 1, 1936. His brother, Edwin, played mandolin in the band that year. Unfortunately, during 1936 the band disbanded. So, like many others, Carl became part of the Greenwood Post String Band.

After two years there, Carl joined

## TIME FOR CHARLIE

"I would rather keep time for a string band than have someone take a swing at me" .... These are the words of Charles Cunningham, Sr., from the Mayfair section of Philadelphia; official timekeeper for the New Year's Shooters and Mummers Association.

In his younger years, Charlie was an amateur boxer in the bantamweight class. He fought 42 bouts at some memorable arenas, such as "Cambria" and the "Arena".

Asked if he ever fought any well-known boxers, Charlie smiled and said, "No, just amateurs like myself." He had to give up boxing because of the black eyes he received from his opponents. You might ask why. Well, in his full time job with Westinghouse Electric Company, Charlie was made the manager of the store in which he worked. One day the boss took him aside and said, "Charlie, now that you were made Manager of our store, it doesn't look right for you to face our customers with black and blue eyes every week!" ... So, Charlie quit the ring.

However, he did stay associated with boxing as a timekeeper. His most memorable assignment was timekeeping the Marciano-Walcott fight.

It was through his timekeeping duties that he made the acquaintance of Bob Rodenbaugh, then President of the New Year's Shooters and Mummers Association. One day, Rodenbaugh invited Charlie to help him with the New Year's Parade. That was 1953, and a few years later, Rodenbaugh asked Charley to become a timekeeper for the String Bands. What Charlie thought would be a short term position, has lasted over 30 years.

You can see Charlie with his familiar hat and earmuffs, on the Judges' Stand on New Year's Day. As each String Band comes to the starting line to perform for the overflowing crowds, a flag is dropped for the band to step across the starting line. Charlie checks off his time clock and keeps a watch to ensure that the band does not perform any longer than the allotted 4-minutes. He has only had one band that ever went over the official limit and that band was disqualified. This is remarkable, considering how many men and bands were involved since 1953.

Even though he is 84 years young, Charlie has no intention of retiring in the near future. He likes being a timekeeper and tries to do his job the way Rodenbaugh instructed him on his first day as official timekeeper when he said, "Do your best!"

If Rodenbaugh were alive today we are certain he would agree that Charlie has done his best. In fact, every String Band that has marched under Charlie's watchful eye, would agree that he is to be commended for his loyalty, commitment and fairness to all groups.

We all wish Charles Cunningham Sr., many more years of timekeeping duties. Charlie, here's hoping that it never rains on your parade — The Philadelphia Mummers New Year's Parade!

“The Butterfly” costume from 1953 is butterscotch satin, trimmed in orange lamae, black velvet, gold acetate with gold and orange sequins.

“The Four Leaf Clover” costume from 1949, that gave Uptown its theme song, is white moire with green brocade, and trimmed with gold sequins. The backpiece is a four-leaf clover trimmed with white maribou. Many of you may remember that Uptown was the first band to record “Four Leaf Clover”, which became an instant top seller and sold over one million records.

Over the years, many faces have come and gone, but some remain the same. Uptown is proud of a group of men who have 25 years or more of service and dedication to the organization. Uptown is especially proud of its President, Cliff Johnson, Jr., who is the only original member still in the band. Last year Cliff was inducted into the String Band Hall of Fame. This is Cliff’s 50th year on Broad Street.

This year Uptown is reminiscing about the past 50 years, but the most important thing is that the band will be here in the future to continue to entertain the public

as it has in the past. Keeping this in mind, sit back and celebrate with Uptown its 50th Anniversary.

The semicircle sits down...the end men in their elaborate costumes, full of fun and mischief...the interlocutor dignified in his evening dress...the other actors with their banjos, tamborines, saxophones

etc...“Gentlemen, be seated!” and the crowd out front settles down to an evening of entertainment.

Gentlemen, Be Seated offers you a mini minstrel parade synonymous with the old time minstrels parading from the railroad station to the local hotel and a minstrel show which commences when the Interlocutor raises his voice and instructs “Gentlemen, be seated!”

**Music:** Included is music to such songs as “Waiting For The Robert E. Lee”, “Are You From Dixie”, “South”, “Old Kentucky Home”, “Hey, Mr. Banjo”, “Banjo Pickers Ball”, “Camptown Races” and “Toot, Toot Tootsie”.

### Theme: Gentlemen, Be Seated!

### PRESENTATION

“Hey, fellers! Minstrels comin’!” The band enters the judging area as the old time minstrels paraded to the local hotel which was an established ritual. The actual parade of the old time minstrels was the outgrowth of circus habits. As the band comes to a halt, the performers get themselves into position for the show. The band takes its place forming a semi-circle and the In-

terlocutor, situated in the center of the circle instructs for the show to begin. The show consists of three parts. Part one, four of the actors (Banjo Players) play and dance in true minstrel style. Part two, has the Interlocutor along with the two end men, Bones and Tambo, making a surprising entrance with quick feet movement. Part three, the finale, presents three oversized banjos and tamborines, as well as the Interlocutor strutting to a choreographed routine.

**Costume:** The costumes have been designed with the old fashioned minstrel in mind as well as the appeal of today’s mummer. The perimeter of the band is an elaborate costume with an oversized bow-tie and top hat. The predominant color of this suit is cerise and is finished with a backpiece depicting an eight foot tamborine. The inside portion of the band has two different costumes. One being the same as the perimeter except the predominant color is lime green. The other suit is a long gown depicting a long tailed new market coat of startling pattern. All of the suits are accented in colors such as gold, red, orange, cerise, black and lime green. The end men are dressed in absurd and elaborate farce costumes.
