These tasks require endless hours of a string band captain's time; time which is spent away from his family. In this regard, Al is grateful to receive much support and understanding from his wife and two daughters as he pursues this meaningful activity in his life.

Al is glad to be joining three other Aqua String Band members, Fred Kesel, Ed Venckus and Al Primavera, Sr. in the Hall of Fame. He has been a dedicated mummer for 36 years and, in that spirit, the officers and members of the Aqua String Band say congratulations and best wishes for many more years of continued success.



Edward P. Broomall


The Officers and members of the Peter A. Broomall String Band congratulate and are proud to announce that **Edward P. Broomall** has been inducted into the Mummer's' Hall of Fame by his fellow mummeters in Dec. 1987. Ed has been a mummer for 58 years. He has never missed a New Year's parade except when he was in the service from 1943-1945.

Ed was the first mascot of the band in 1931 making him the only person currently performing with the band since that time. After his years as mascot he learned the banjo and played in the band, then moved onto learn sax. He has played the alto, tenor, baritone and bass sax through the years and has served as the band's music director in the late 50's and early 60's. Ed's musical talents don't stop with banjo and sax, he

has also studied voice and piano at the 20th Century Music Studio in Philadelphia, once on Locust Street, now located in the Shubert Bldg. on Broad Street.

Ed also has some artistic flair for costume and backpiece design and has worked with the development and making of costumes and backpieces over the years.

Ed is currently playing tenor sax in the band and serves as Vice President of the Board of Directors. Ed follows his brother, James and his father, Peter into the Hall of Fame — making it a family affair.

KEN STEIN, JR.

The Hegeman String Band is proud to introduce their "*Man Behind the Scenes*" for 1988 — *Ken Stein, Sr.*

Ken started out in Mummery in the early 50's. He was an accordion player with Uptown String Band for two years. In 1952 Ken joined Hegeman String Band for two years. In 1957 Ken switched from the accordion to alto saxophone. Over the years, Ken has held several different positions within Hegeman, including Chairman of the Board for six years, Assistant Drill Master, Music Arranger and presently he serves as Music Librarian. Ken has also been a member of the Music and Theme Committees. Ken's biggest achievement came in 1983-84 when Hegeman String Band was reorganized. He was instrumental in making Hegeman String Band a truly democratic organization.

Ken resides in Washington Township, NJ with his wife Lillian, his mother and his two sons, Ken, Jr. and Timmy who also play the saxophone with Hegeman.

Ken's unselfish attitude, leadership and the dedication he has given to the Hegeman string Band will never be forgotten.

The Hegeman String Band would like to thank Ken for everything he has done.

OLD TIMERS HALL OF FAME JOSEPH GIARDINO, SR.

This year's inductee into the highly honored *Old Timers Hall of Fame* is the late *Joseph Giardino, Sr.* Joe was a member of Greater Kensington String Band from 1960 until his death in December, 1983. All the band members are deeply touched that such an honor has been bestowed on one of their members.

Joe started his Mummery career as a harmonica player in Uptown String Band in 1940. He very quickly became a tenor saxophone player and eventually was named Music Director of Uptown. Joe Giardino, Sr. was privileged to be the band director when Uptown made the now famous recording of "Four Leaf Clover" in 1947.

Joe stayed with Uptown until moving to Greater Kensington in 1960. He was elected Music Director in Kensington and served from 1963 to 1966 when a

brain hemorrhage almost took his life. Joe recovered from brain surgery and returned as Music Director from 1969 to 1972 when he retired as an active band member. In 1975, he was elected as a lifetime member of the Greater Kensington String Band.

In addition to being a band director, Joe Giardino, Sr. taught people how to play the saxophone. His teaching has had an influence on the parade itself. He taught people of Aqua, Avalon, Crean, Duffy, Ferko, Fralinger, Greater Kensington, Hegeman, Northeast, Polish American, Quaker City, Ukranian American, Uptown and Woodland String Bands.

Joe's two sons are marching this year. Joe Giardino, Jr. is with Ferko and John Giardino is with Greater Kensington.

May God bless you, Joe Giardino, Sr. and thank you!

As we celebrate our 50th Anniversary, a moment of reflection seems quite appropriate.

On May 11, 1938 the Avalon String Band was organized by Harry T. Lawson. Harry would lead his new group up Broad Street for the first time on January 1, 1939 and would continue to do so until 1971, when due to health reasons, he was forced to retire. After his demise in June of 1974, a new group gained control of the band and would continue to march under the Avalon banner until 1982, when due to financial difficulties and organizational problems, Avalon failed to march up Broad Street for the first time in 44 years. In Philadelphia, a String Band who misses two consecutive parades loses their charter and the privilege of marching in the Mummers Parade. On March 23, 1982 the band was reorganized by a group of veteran mummers and on January 1, 1983 a 'New' Avalon String Band eagerly returned to Broad Street. In our five short years of reorganization, we have finished out of 27 String Bands: 12th, 4th, 3rd, 7th and 9th respectively.
