



More significant however, is the fact that Bob is a creative builder of Captain

backpieces. He has built the backpiece for every Captain in Kensington since 1958. Every Captain he has built for in the band has been a winner.

Bob also has worked for other bands. Since 1958, Bob has played a part in constructing a winning Captain's suit a total of 21 times. Whenever Kensington is close to selecting a theme you will always hear the phrase, "Let's ask Bob Morrissey."

Originally from Lawndale, Bob now makes his home in Bucks County.

THEME: "L'CHAIM"

PRESENTATION

The festive nature of Jewish culture grew out of the oppression and suffering of many years, and "tradition" became the cultural stabilizer that sustained and balanced their historical growth through the changing years. The band presents a theatrical simulation of that festivity and tradition from the day of the parting of the Red Sea through the years of Russian oppression, by highlighting certain historical characters and events, and by drawing upon traditional songs ("EXODUS", "L'CHAIM", "COSSACK SONG", "BEI MIR BISTU SHEIN", "FIDDLER ON THE ROOF", "IF I WERE A RICH MAN", "HAVAH NAGILAH", "YOSSELL YOSSELL") and dances that bridged the transition from the past to the present.

COSTUMES

The costumes are influenced in design and color by the biblical years of the Exodus, featuring Moses; the High Priest; and the Hebrew slaves fleeing from Egypt. To enhance a sense of historicity, each band member is bearded, in accordance with the traditions of the early Jewish community. The later time period of Czarist Russia contributes to the costume design of the spirited townspeople of Anatevka, who dance as an expression of thanksgiving and hope for the future. The captain fills the dual-role of two "dreamers". He enters first as the young shepherd "JOSEPH AND HIS COAT OF MANY COLORS" who could grasp a sense of the future by means of his dreams. He then becomes one of the villagers of Anatevka, portraying "TEVYE", the poor village milkman who eases his impoverished lifestyle by his daydreams of being a "RICH MAN".

His costumes are elaborately appointed with sequins, mirrors and jewels. Merlin the Magician is costumed in mystical robes of midnight blue.
