



1991 Philadelphia Mummies' String Band Hall of Fame



William J. Speziale

The members of the Joseph A. Ferko String Band are proud to announce the induction of their Captain, William J. Speziale, into the Mummies Hall of Fame.

Bill marched in his first Mummies parade in 1958 at the age of fourteen with the Liberty Clown Comic Club. During his high school years, Bill began studying music and in 1960 joined the Hegeman String Band. He remained with Hegeman as their glockenspiel player until 1968. Bill is grateful to Al Fink and the Hegeman members for the opportunity of being a part of their organization for nine years.

In 1968, Bill was recruited by John Gilbert to join the Joseph A. Ferko String Band as their glockenspiel player. He played "bells" with Ferko for eight years and served under John Gilbert as assistant Drill Director in 1975 & 1976. In 1977, Bill was elected Co-Drill Director with Tom King (another Hall of Fame Member). Together, Bill and Tom created many memorable and exciting presentations including "Showboat Review",

"Hobo Hi-Jinx", "G.I. Jive", and the 1982 1st Prize performance of "Golden Memories of the Bowery."

During a special election in June of 1979, as a write-in candidate, Bill was elected Captain. He became the third successor of the bands' beloved founder, Joe Ferko, to carry the prestigious title of "Captain" of the Joseph A. Ferko String Band.

Bill's showmanship, creativity and talents immediately came forward in his New Years' day performances. His roles as General Patton ("G.I. Jive"), Diamond Jim Brady ("The Bowery"), the Lion ("Silly Symfunny") and his performances in "Raggs Time" and "At the Strutters Ball" are just a sample of his credits and accomplishments. In retrospect, Bill has received one of the top six captain's prizes in 10 of the 12 years he has been the marching leader of the Ferko String Band. These awards include two 3rd prizes, two 2nd prizes and three 1st prizes in 1982, 1985 and 1988. It is obvious that Bill Speziale's style, technique and personality have brought excitement, pleasure and enjoyment to the New Year's day Mummies Parade while also establishing a new level of expectations for the role of string band captains.

Bill is certainly proud of this distinguished honor. Further, Bill commented that "being inducted into the Hall of Fame is one of the most significant privileges I have ever received." As a Mummer, Bill has put forth a great deal of time, energy and dedication. To be rewarded for his talents and time makes everything seem worthwhile. Bill is indebted to all of his fellow Mummies and especially the members of Ferko for this distinguished honor. Bill is also grateful to his family for their unending love and support.

David E. Anderson, Jr.

Everyone in the Woodland String Band Family rejoices in the induction of David E. Anderson Jr. into the Philadelphia Mummies' String Band Hall of Fame, and we wholeheartedly congratulate him on having earned the distinguished honor that symbolizes the admiration and respect of his peers.

Dave represents the third generation of Andersons to receive this prestigious recognition. His father, Captain Dave Anderson, Sr. was inducted into the Hall of Fame in 1968, and his grandfather, David "Pop" Anderson is a member of the Old Timers Hall of Fame.

On January 1, 1991, Dave marched in his thirty-sixth New Years Day Parade, an impressive record that began in 1955 when he first marched as a child mascot to his father. As the years progressed, so did Dave's involvement in Mummery. Under the tutelage of Music Director Joseph L. Bresset (Dave's uncle, who is also a member of the Hall of Fame), he became an accomplished musician and an integral part of the playing ranks of the band. As he matured in life, he matured in the greater responsibility of

leadership within the Officer ranks of the Woodland String Band. He served in various Officer and Committee positions, most visibly when he served as the band's Drill Master for many, many years. And, having served as part of the Woodland String Band's delegation in the Philadelphia Mummies' and String Band Associations, the frame work of his involvement in the tradition of Mummery was extended when he became a Director for the String Band Division of that association.

While tenure and position certainly frame the portrait of a "lifetime mummer", character and virtue are the higher values that portray the true image of a member of the Hall of Fame. Dave's reverence for the tradition of Mummery cultivate his motivation within that tradition. His dedication and loyalty to the tradition of Mummery are nourished by his respect and admiration for everyone who participates in that tradition. And, his sense of selflessness and reserve identify him with the men who preceded him in the preservation and furtherance of this great Philadelphia tradition. Yet all of these attributes stem from the even more fundamental fact of Dave being a good person — a gentleman in the fullest and finest sense of the word. This character trait was woven into his personality by his parents, Dave and Floss Anderson, and continues to be encouraged and supported by his wife, Mary, and his daughters, Kelly and Chrissy. We acknowledge each of them for their contributions and sacrifices that have enabled us to reap the benefits of the talents and gifts that Dave brings to every Philadelphia Mummer.

We are grateful to the Philadelphia Mummies String Band Association delegation for recognizing and acknowledging Dave's outstanding and prestigious achievements. We congratulate him for having earned the respect and honor of his peers. He started in mummery with the Fralinger String Band in 1966 and has paraded every year since. In 1981, John left Fralinger to march with the South Philadelphia String Band. He left South Philadelphia to be an intricate part of the reorganizing of Avalon in 1982.

John has served on Avalon's Board of Directors and Chairman of our Fund Raiser Committee every year since 1982. Ozzie's leadership has taken a band in debt and no capital funds in 1982 to where we have owned two clubs and placed in the top ten since 1983. Ozzie is the first to admit that this was accomplished with the work and cooperation of the members of Avalon, past and present. It is his guidance and determination that has led us to this achievement. It is Ozzie's nature to be "behind the

scenes" because of his desires of band accomplishments rather than personal attribution.

John's value to Avalon can not be measured only in dollars. John's musical talents and heart are of a greater value to us. At various times through our various themes, John has played Bass, Baritone, Tenor and Alto saxophones at the Musical Directors request. Their is no stronger heart in Avalon than Ozzie's. He has never let us quit when we were down and he has led the celebration when we have done well.

Ozzie's dedication to the well being of Avalon has not been accomplished without sacrifice of time for his family - his wife Delores, his three daughters Jamie, Janine, & Janae and his mother Laura. Their loss has been our gain, which has been the backbone of Avalon's successes in the 80's and early 90's.

OLD TIMER HALL OF FAME



MICKEY MALLON

If ever a man was worthy of induction into the Mummery Hall of Fame, it is undoubtedly John "Mickey" Mallon.

Mickey was always fun to be around. He led Greater Kensington String Band up Broad Street for seven years as the band's Captain. Mickey, a dynamic showman, was a well recognized marching Captain whose loyalty and devotion to mummery was unsurpassed. It was a treat to watch him perform.

His big backpieces have become a part of mummery's legend. He was first prize captain in 1970, second in 1964 and 1969, and fourth in 1967.

In 1965 Mickey received an honorable mention award for marching with a 167 pound Disneyland backpiece.

Mickey started originally with the Uptown String Band and came to Greater Kensington in 1953. He was elected the band's Captain and marched in front of the band in the 1964 parade.

A back injury eventually ended Mickey's marching career. With him went a degree of enthusiasm and showmanship that was very rare.

Whenever a discussion gets around to the "great" marching captains, the name Mickey Mallon is always included.
